

Crayon Technique on Fabric

Supply List

Crayons (Crayola brand recommended since there is more color in them)

Design

Iron

Paper towels

Process

- Press area to be colored until hot (do not scorch)
- Hold crayon on the hot area until you feel it start to melt
- Use the crayon like a brush to tint and color design
- Cover design with a paper towel
- Press with iron to set color

Tips:

- As heat dissipates, the color will not be as intense
- Keep area warm to avoid coloring lines; reheat as necessary to get the tint desired
- Use both flat area of the crayon to fill areas
- Use point of crayon to outline or to color near edges of design
- Different colors can be overlaid for tinting and shading in the design. Set color before adding another.
